



# 100 Club in aid of ShelterBox



## Application Form

### How the Club Works

Every entry will be assigned a number from 1 to 100. In the last week of each month winning numbers will be drawn (normally at the last Scout meeting of the month). There will be up to 4 winners each month, the number and value of the prizes will depend on the number of people in the club that month (see below). Each month approximately 50% of the entry fees will be donated to ShelterBox and 50% will be given out as prizes.

No of Members	No of Prizes	Prize Values
1-29	1	50% of total money (up to maximum of £10)
30-49	2	1 <sup>st</sup> prize of £10-15, 2 <sup>nd</sup> prize of £5
50-69	3	1 <sup>st</sup> prize of £15, 2 <sup>nd</sup> prize of £5-9, 3 <sup>rd</sup> prize of £5
70-100	4	1 <sup>st</sup> prize of £15-20, 2 <sup>nd</sup> prize of £10-15, 3 <sup>rd</sup> prize of £5-10, 4 <sup>th</sup> prize of £5

The draws take place towards the end of each month and include all entries received (*with payment*) by then. Entries received will always start from the next available draw.

***Don't forget to rejoin when your entries run out if you want to remain in the club.***
